- Moving of Horse Barn
 - It was discovered doing a walk around that building is of hybrid construction with 4x4 posts in the corners. We will need to have electrical moved from the horse barn to a panel along the fence before we can move it. Matt was going to inquire with Finley Lumber about some kind of steel French doors to use for a new doorway. Brian was to come up with some aerial pictures of the move and where things will be in the new setup. Plan is to put steel siding and roofing on it to match the big barn. Will have a sloped apron from the pad going north to allow ADA compliance. Will have (2) windows put in the lower portion on the south. New French Doors (if we can get them) will be on the North. Upstairs will be used as storage and be locked during the fair so no one can be up in the top. Power should be able to be brought in from the barn.

Idea for Big Barn: Brian asked if w could do some kind of digital sign to put on the front of the big barn instead of changing the manual sign every year. He will research and come up with ideas and costs. This could be the Fair boards' big item for the celebration next year.
